The Club has a firm financial footing but we cannot afford to be complacent, we have been rewarded for our successes this season with a number of cash awards, but these cannot be relied upon year on year. Our aim will continue to be delivering the highest quality Basketball for our members at the lowest cost we can, but some increases may be unavoidable in the season to come.
